COLD OPEN

EXT. FOREST - DAY, FLASHBACK

Birds sing in the calm and quiet wilderness.

A SMALL CHILD, enters the quiet woods, with a bundle slung over their shoulder. They gaze around the woods.

SMALL CHILD

Small waves of colors and sparkling bits of magical dust emit from the trees.

END OF COLD OPEN

ACT ONE**INT. THE BREW - MORNING**

Emily, a 12 year old witch wearing a magical amulet and a glowing personality, is practicing her magical powers on some pots and pans in the kitchen of the coffee shop. They form the shape of person.

MEREDITH, Emily's poufy red headed adopted mother, is gathering materials from the kitchen cabinets to bake a cake. One of the pans wizzes past her head to join Emily's formation.

MEREDITH

Emily, I need some of those for the cake.

EMILY

But this is so fun mommy.

The shape of the pots and pans start dancing.

INT. LIVING ROOM OF THE BREW - CONTINUOUS

On the other side of the coffee shop/house, DESTINY, Meredith's wife and Emily's second mom - also a witch, is cleaning the living room. Her owl familiar, ANTHENA, just sits on her perch and watches.

DESTINY

(sarcastic)

Thanks for the help Athena.

Athena Hoots back at her. Some of Destiny's hair falls into her face. She blows it out of the way.

Just then, Destiny hears a massive amount of clanging of pots and pans coming from the kitchen. Emily shouts in the distance.

EMILY (O.S.)

Sorry.

INT. THE BREW

Meredith stops stirring the mixing bowl and puts it down.

MEREDITH

You need to be more careful Emily!

Meredith approaches Emily, checking to make sure she's okay.

EMILY

I'm sorry mommy. I'm still getting used to my powers.

Destiny enters from the other room.

DESTINY

Is everything alright?

MEREDITH

Emily just had some trouble maintaining an animation spell.

EMILY

I just wanted someone to play with, that's all.

MEREDITH

Well, you could go around town and invite some people to your party? It'd be a great way to-

DESTINY

No that's too dangerous.

MEREDITH

It's daytime and wonderfully safe here.

DESTINY

She could wander too far and hurt herself.

MEREDITH

It'd be a great way for her to make some friends.

EMILY

I'd love to do it!

MEREDITH

Plus, it could lead to a nice big party Destiny.

Destiny grins at that.

DESTINY

Alright, alright. I don't wanna be the bad guy. That sounds like fun, but don't wander into the woods. It's dangerous out there.

Meredith lifts her right hand, opened out, and gestures with her other hand. POOF. A stack of paper invitations appear in her hand.

MEREDITH
Here you go sweetie.

Emily takes the cards.

EMILY
Thank you mommy, thanks mamma!

Emily heads towards the door.

MEREDITH
Make sure you wear a coat, it's a little chilly outside.

EMILY
I will.

MEREDITH
And remember don't venture too far out. There's bears,-

DESTINY
And Giants-

MEREDITH
And werewolves too!

Emily takes her coat off the rack and puts it on.

EMILY
Is that supposed to be scary?
Because that sounds fun.

MEREDITH
Believe me, werewolves are no fun.

Destiny crosses her arms.

DESTINY
That was one time and it wasn't his fault.

Meredith narrows her eyes at Destiny.

MEREDITH
Sorry. But, that's not helping.

EMILY
I'll be safe. Love you mom, love you mama!

Emily runs out the door.

CUT TO:

EXT. AUTUMN SPRINGS, OUTSIDE THE BREW - DAY

Emily runs outside the door, with some of the paper invitations flying in the wind.

CUT TO:

MONTAGE - DAY

A) EXT. MISTER FOX'S HOUSE - Emily runs up to MR.FOX's place. She knocks on his door, and waits.

Mr.Fox opens the door.

MISTER FOX

Hello?

EMILY

Hi, my mothers are throwing a party at the Brew.

She hands Mr.Fox an invitation.

EMILY (CONT'D)

And you're invited!

MISTER FOX

Oh, that's very kind of you, but I'm very busy tonight. Dreadfully sorry. Good day though.

He closes the door on her. Emily's smile fades.

B) EXT. OZZY'S HUT - Emily walks up to a small wooden hut with a straw roof. She knocks on the door. Out walks OZZY, a teenage nonbinary (They/Them) Scarecrow with rope dreadlocks.

OZZY

Hello! Oh you're the new girl in town, right? I'm Ozzy.

EMILY

Nice to meet you. I'm Emily, and my moms are hosting a party.

She hands them an invitation.

OZZY

Bodacious, this looks rad. I'd love to come.

They tuck the invitation into their pocket, then suddenly their eyes grow wide.

OZZY (CONT'D)

Wait, there won't be a bonfire, will there?

EMILY

Oh, um. I'm not sure.

OZZY

I'll come prepared just in case.

C) EXT. Gretchen's Gingerbread House - Emily knocks on a gingerbread door. The door opens, and GRETCHEN, a gingerbread girl with pig tails in wheel chair, rolls into the doorway.

GRETCHEN

Hi.

She sniffs, and blows her nose.

GRETCHEN (CONT'D)

Sorry, I'm getting over the frosties.

EMILY

Oh. Well, my name's Emily, and my moms are hosting a party at the Brew. Wanna come?

Emily hands Gretchen an invitation. She looks at it carefully, and then places it down on her lap.

GRETCHEN

I might come, but I don't wanna get anyone sick.

EMILY

Okay, well...

GRETCHEN

Oh, Gretchen.

EMILY

Well Gretchen, if you feel better, you're more than welcome to come!

GRETCHEN

Thank you.

She smiles shyly.

D) EXT. OAK HILLS - Emily skips through town, invitations fly in the air leading to a nice scene transition. *

E) EXT. OLD TORTOISE'S CABIN - Emily is standing outside, speaking with an OLD TORTOISE, with thick glasses and a cardigan and turtle neck sweater. He has a TINY TURTLE on his head. *

OLD TORTOISE
I'd love to come, but I need take care of this whipper snapper. Thank you for invite though.

He slowly gestures at his granddaughter on his head.

EMILY
No worries, have a good day!

OLD TORTOISE
You as well kiddo.

F) EXT. OAK HILLS HOUSE - A man stands at the doorway, as Emily eagerly awaits to hear his response. *

MAN
Sorry, I can't come. *

G) EXT. OAK HILLS HOME 2 - A WOMAN WITH GLASSES and a turtle neck sweater, holds a steaming cup of tea. She looks to Emily and then back to her computer inside. *

WOMAN WITH GLASSES
I'm sorry, I can't. Today's my writing day. *

H) EXT. ANGRY OWL'S DOOR - An OLD ANGRY OWL leaps at Emily, his glasses fall down. *

ANGRY OLD OWL
Whoo are you?! Get out! Get out of my sight! *

Emily runs away scared. *

EMILY
Ah! *

I) VARIOUS DOORWAYS - Multiple people and anthropomorphized animals slam their doors closed after saying no. *

RANDOM CITIZEN 1
No. *

RANDOM CITIZEN 2
Sorry, I'm busy.

Emily's expression grows sadder with each house she visits.

RANDOM CITIZEN 3
I don't know you!

J) EXT. OLD MAN'S HOUSE - An OLD MAN leans in to try to hear Emily.

OLD MAN
What was that?

EMILY
I'm hosting a party and I want you to come!

OLD MAN
You're roasting Marty to make them feel glum? That's so mean. Kids these days have no decency.

EMILY
That's not what--

OLD MAN
--I'll have no part of this!

He slams the door on her.

MONTAGE END.

CUT TO:

EXT. AUTUMN SPRINGS PARK - DAY

Emily sits on a stump, her head in her hand. She looks through the list of mostly crossed out names. She sighs.

A FROG hops in front of her.

EMILY
Do you want to come to the party Mr.Frog?

The frog ribbits and then hops away.

EMILY (CONT'D)
Fine! I was only inviting you to be nice.

She tosses some of the invitations down on the ground.

Emily walks around and picks up a twig with a dead leaf attached to it.

EMILY (CONT'D)
At least I have you.

The leaf flies away. Emily grows more annoyed. She groans, when suddenly her amulet sparkles.

EMILY (CONT'D)
Wait a minute!

She looks at the twig in her hand as if it were a wand.

EMILY (CONT'D)
I got an idea!

She looks to the local library across the street. She picks up the invitations and runs towards the library.

CUT TO:

INT. THE BREW - DAY

Destiny walks in from the other room, as Meredith is prepping the cake and oven.

DESTINY
Meredith darling, the rest of the house is all set for the party...

Meredith is noticeably stressed out, several ingredients are floating around in the air. A spoon stirs a bowl in the air by itself.

DESTINY (CONT'D)
Is everything alright?

MEREDITH
(Shouting to self)
Where is my margarine?!

The margarine floats past her in the air. Destiny grabs it and hands it to her.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)
That's embarrassing.

DESTINY
Looks like you're making good progress.

MEREDITH

No, this cake isn't turning out right and Emily's package still isn't here yet.

DESTINY

We've still got a good 6 hours before anybody shows up.

MEREDITH

No, this has to be perfect! This is Emily's first birthday party. We've got to make it special!

Destiny puts her arm on Meredith's shoulder.

DESTINY

It already is special, just by virtue of it being her first. Plus, I'm sure it won't be her last.

MEREDITH

Yeah, you're right, it's just--

Suddenly, a letter with wings flies and hits the window, creating a loud SMACK. It startles both of them.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

Ah!

DESTINY

Ah!

Meredith opens the window and lets the flying envelope in.

The letter flies into Meredith's hands. She levitates a knife towards her to open it. Destiny jumps out of the way.

DESTINY (CONT'D)

Careful.

MEREDITH

Sorry.

She opens the letter and reads.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

We regret to inform you that your package was held up in air traffic, and won't arrive for another two days. Please pardon any delays... What?!

DESTINY

They were able to send the letter on time but not the package? What's up with that?

MEREDITH

With all the magic in the world,
you'd think they'd just use a
teleportation spell for people who
pay extra for express shipping.

DESTINY

It's ridiculous!

Meredith looks around before she gets an IDEA.

MEREDITH

I've a got stupid idea.

She grabs her broom hanging on the wall.

DESTINY

What're you doing?

MEREDITH

I need this present to arrive for
Emily.

DESTINY

You're gonna fly after it?!

MEREDITH

I know you said that today doesn't
have to be perfect but I have to
get this right.

Destiny looks deep into Meredith's eyes.

DESTINY

I know I can't stop you, just be
safe.

Meredith smiles, Destiny kisses her.

DESTINY (CONT'D)

I'll take care of everything else
going on here.

MEREDITH

Thank you so much darling.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO**EXT. OAK HILLS LIBRARY, EAST WING - DAY**

Emily wanders through the warm cozy library, looking around at the various signs.

EMILY

Fiction, Nonfiction, Mystery, Cook
Books, Adventure, Young adult...
ugh, where are the spell books?!

Emily walks up to the LIBRARIAN, he's a balding frog with a monocle.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Excuse me?

LIBRARIAN

Mmmm yes!

EMILY

Where's the spell book section?

The librarian flails his arms around

LIBRARIAN

Oh yes, it's down at end of the
main hall to the right, then make a
left, then a right, and go forward
past the biography section, and
then you'll make one last left...
or was another right?

EMILY

Uhh... are there any signs that
illustrate where it is?

LIBRARIAN

But of course!

EMILY

Okay thank you--

LIBRARIAN

--Wait! The directions I gave you
may have been for the government
paperwork section. I'm dreadfully
sorry darling I'm old and I haven't
been to that section in a minute.

EMILY

Isn't it your job to know where things are?

LIBRARIAN

I don't do it all myself. Haven't for a long while. That's what my assistants are for.

A tiny six inch ELF drops down from the return bookshelf behind the Librarian.

ELF ASSISTANT

Hi.

EMILY

Neat. So, the spell book section?

ELF ASSISTANT

Follow me!

The elf scampers off.

LIBRARIAN

Good luck darling!

CUT TO:

INT. OAK HILLS LIBRARY, WEST WING - DAY

Emily and the Elf walk out of a corridor and into a large room filled with books wall to wall. She waves to the left.

ELF ASSISTANT

Here we are, the magic section. On this side, spell books, organized by skill level, type of magic, and age.

The Elf waves to the right.

ELF ASSISTANT (CONT'D)

On this end, potion recipes, bestiaries, almanacs, history records, and other miscellaneous texts. Let me know if you need anything.

EMILY

Thank you.

The elf leaps up the wall and into a secret passageway for Elves.

Emily looks at the spell book section.

EMILY (CONT'D)
War spells, Life spells, Gardening
spells... there's a whole book on
gardening spells? Momma would love
this.

She grabs the book off the shelf. She continues looking until she finds a book on SOCIAL MAGIC on a shelf really high up.

EMILY (CONT'D)
There!

She looks around for the elf. He's nowhere to be seen.

EMILY (CONT'D)
Mister elf?

Her voice echoes across the west wing. A distant voice responds.

DISTANT VOICE
Ssshh!

EMILY
(Whispers to self)
Okay, then. I'll do it myself.

Emily looks around for a stool and finds a chair near a study table.

She runs to it, picks it up, and moves it close to the wall of bookcases.

She stands on the chair but she's still not tall enough.

EMILY (CONT'D)
Ugh.

She spots a levitation book and that gives her an idea.

She claps her hands, and then waves them around. Trying to use magic to get the book.

The book wiggles a bit, but not much progress. Emily tries harder. It moves farther, but still stuck. She tries once more.

Suddenly tens of books fly off the shelf she was trying to grab it from.

DISTANT VOICE
Ssshhh!

She cringes.

EMILY

Sorry.

She picks up the correct book and sets it aside.

She picks up the other books that fell and places them on the table nearby. She brushes her hair out of her face.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Okay, let's hope there's something
in here.

She opens the book of social spells and starts reading.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. OAK HILLS LIBRARY, WEST WING - LATER

Emily turns through the pages until she finds exactly what she was looking for.

EMILY

Bingo! A persuasion spell.

She mumbles some of the text.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Gesture your like so, and say;
Goddess oh goddess, Guide my hand,
Take my words that I command, Let
them hear and let them see, Let
them listen to none but me.

Wind echoes within the room.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Whoa, cool.

She closes the book, keeping a finger between the pages.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Sounds easy enough.

CUT TO:

INT. OAK HILLS LIBRARY, EAST WING- LATER

Emily walks up to the librarian.

LIBRARIAN

Did you find what you were looking
for miss?

EMILY

Yuppers.

She starts waving her hands.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Goddess oh goddess, Guide my hand,
Take my words that I command, Let
them hear and let them see, Let
them listen to none but me.

The frog's eyes glow white.

EMILY (CONT'D)

Whoa, cool.

She pulls out one of the paper invitations Meredith gave her.

EMILY (CONT'D)

You're really interesting and
invited to my party. Please come.

LIBRARIAN

As you wish darling.

The Librarian's eyes stop glowing.

EMILY

See you at the party!

LIBRARIAN

Thank you for coming by, child!

CUT TO:

MONTAGE - DAY

A) EXT. MISTER FOX'S HOUSE - Emily runs up to the door of
Mr. Fox's place again. She rehearses the spell to herself

EMILY

[Repeating the words of the spell
followed by] You're coming to my
party.

[Emily goes back to the various people and critters she met
earlier, this time using magic to manipulate them into
coming.]

MONTAGE END.

CUT TO:

EXT. HIGH IN SKY - DAY

A calm quiet cloudscape is disrupted by a rush of sweeping wind. Meredith flies through the clouds breaking them apart as she whooshes through.

She looks down below, as the clouds sail in the wind. A huge rush of wind blows through her hair. She frowns.

MEREDITH

God, I hope that storm isn't close.

She continues her flight when a huge wave of wind changes her course.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

Aaah!

She manages to ride through the howling winds. She darts upward above some of the clouds.

CUT TO:

EXT. OAK HILLS OUTSKIRTS - DAY

Emily prances away from the last cottage she knocked on with a skip in her step.

She stops, and pulls out her bag only to see a few more invitations still remain.

EMILY

There's still more? Ugh, even with magic I'll never be able to invite enough people. This party has be absolutely perfect!

She falls to the ground. She then spots a few more houses and cabins out in the distance, deep into the woods.

EMILY (CONT'D)

There's still more people to invite!

She leaps up, grabbing her bag, and runs into the forest.

CUT TO:

EXT. BLAIR'S HOUSE - DAY

Emily knocks on a door of an old spooky log cabin. She clears her throat.

BLAIR, a hairy half-werewolf half-human teenage girl, opens the door. Emily is caught off guard. *

BLAIR

Hi.

EMILY

Whoa.

BLAIR

Are you some sort of girl scout or--

Emily pulls out one of her invitations and shoves it in Blair's face.

EMILY

Goddess oh goddess, Guide my hand--

BLAIR

--Are you trying to use magic on me?

Emily's eyes go wide.

EMILY

No...

Blair laughs.

BLAIR

You're a bad liar.

EMILY

Sorry.

BLAIR

What's this about anyway?

EMILY

Oh, that's an invite for my moms' party. They wanted me to invite a bunch of people all over town.

BLAIR

Are you using magic to invite people?

Emily shrinks.

EMILY
Yes...

BLAIR
Sick.

EMILY
Really?

BLAIR
Yeah, that's so cool! How many
people did you invite?

EMILY
The whole town...

BLAIR
The whole town!

Emily nods.

BLAIR (CONT'D)
What a legend. I'm so coming to
this.

EMILY
You're not mad I tried to cast a
spell on you?

BLAIR
You failed hilariously.

EMILY
Fair enough.

BLAIR
Besides, you seem cool.

Blair does a soft arm punch and turns back to her house, and
shouts into the open door.

BLAIR (CONT'D)
Dad, I'm going out.

RUDOLPH LOVELL, Blair's dad and a full werewolf, howls from
the other room inside the house.

RUDOLPH LOVELL (O.S.)
Nooooooow, wait a moment.

Rudolph approaches the front door, standing behind Blair.

RUDOLPH LOVELL (CONT'D)
What is this about?

BLAIR

New girl is inviting me to a party.

RUDOLPH LOVELL

Oh I love parties, where is it at?

BLAIR

At my mothers place, The Brew.

RUDOLPH LOVELL

Oh I adore Meredith and Destiny. I haven't been to the Brew in a minute. What time does it start?

BLAIR

Dad, please don't embarrass me.

EMILY

It starts at six.

RUDOLPH LOVELL

Well we don't have much time. Oooh, I should bake some brownies, Destiny loves my recipe.

Rudolph runs back inside.

BLAIR

We still got some time, wanna explore? I bet you've never been this far out.

EMILY

I need to hand out all the invitations. I wanna make my mothers proud--

BLAIR

Calm down dude. You're way too worried about this. It's just a party, not a town meeting.

EMILY

I'm sorry.

BLAIR

Why are you sorry? You do know that parties don't always need to be crazy ragers, right? Sometimes it's nice just to be around a few friends.

EMILY

I... I've just never been to a party.

Blair's eyes go wide.

BLAIR

No way. Did you grow up under a rock?

Emily goes quiet.

BLAIR (CONT'D)

Well rock girl, I don't know what your life was like before you came here, but tonight, you're gonna learn how to party.

Blair grabs her flannel jacket from the inside coat rack and then the two of them head back into town.

FADE TO BLACK.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE**EXT. HIGH IN SKY - DAY, LATER**

A big cardboard BOX, with wings, swims across the sea of clouds.

CUT TO:

INT. CAT BOX IN THE SKY - CONTINUOUS

A CAT is sitting in a well-furnished room on the inside of the box. The Cat licks his paw.

CUT TO:

EXT. HIGH IN SKY - CONTINUOUS

Meredith riding across the clouds on her broom as if she was on jet ski in the water, sees the Box with wings in the distance.

She reaches into her coat to pull out the letter, but the wind blows it out of her hands she screams.

She does a quick loop de loop in the air and catches the letter before it blew too far away.

She scans the letter and then looks back to the Box in the distance.

MEREDITH

That's the one!

She speeds towards the box, and catches up to it.

The Box avoids Meredith, as she tries to catch it.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

Hey!

She grabs the box, but the Box's wings repeatedly slap Meredith in the face, messing up her hair.

Steam spews from her ears and nose.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

I ordered this package.

A mouth design on the Box opens up and speaks.

BOX

I'm sorry madam but I can't let you take me. I need to go to the Cloud Queendom--

MEREDITH

You're for Meredith Philomena, and you're heading to Oak Hills.

BOX

You could've just read my label, there's no proof--

Meredith shows the letter to the Box, holding the note with both hands as the wind blows the edges. The Box sighs.

BOX (CONT'D)

Ugh, this really isn't company policy miss Meredith.

The Cat meows from inside the box.

MEREDITH

Please, it's an emergency. I ordered you for rush delivery. The Cat is for my daughter's birthday.

BOX

It's her birthday! Then we haven't much time.

MEREDITH

Exactly!

BOX

Than you can take me with you.

MEREDITH

Thank you.

She grabs the Box, and the two of them speed away.

CUT TO:

EXT. THE BREW - SUNSET

Blair and Emily walk towards the Brew, which is now crowded with people who move and act as if they're all mildly intoxicated (a side effect from the spell).

BLAIR

Oh my god.

EMILY

Wow, I invited more people than I thought.

BLAIR

This is impressive.

EMILY

Scary.

BLAIR

I'm sure it'll be fine.

There's a shouting the distance.

DESTINY (O.S.)

I'm sorry but we're closed.

RANDOM CITIZEN

But I'm here for Emily's party.

LIBRARIAN

I am too!

DESTINY

(confused shouting)

How are all you here for this party?

Emily and Blair walk a lot closer to the front entrance.

EMILY

Hey Momma.

DESTINY

Emily, why are all these people here?

RANDOM CITIZEN 2

(very slurred)

I'm here for the party.

DESTINY

I didn't ask you.

RANDOM CITIZEN 3

Oh I'm here for the party too.

DESTINY

Stop it!

RANDOM CITIZEN 1

No way man, me too.

Destiny sighs.

Emily and Blair walk up to Destiny. Destiny frowns and taps her foot.

DESTINY

Child you are a beautiful soul, and this town is a wonderfully loving place, but be honest. Did you invite all these people?

EMILY

Technically, yes.

DESTINY

Emily.

Emily shrinks.

EMILY

I'm sorry Momma.

DESTINY

What did you do?

EMILY

I went to the library and learned a spell to--

DESTINY

You used magic to manipulate people to come!?

EMILY

I just wanted to make you and mommy proud.

Emily starts to cry.

DESTINY

Baby girl, you didn't need do that. We were hosting this party for you. We wanted to make you happy.

Emily leaps into an embrace with Destiny.

EMILY

I love you so much Momma.

DESTINY

I love you too.

The break their embrace.

DESTINY (CONT'D)
But all these people who aren't
enchanted need to go home.

EMILY
Okay.

BLAIR
Can I stay?

DESTINY
Oh, hi Blair. Of course you can.
You aren't under the spell are you?

Blair pretends to be drunk.

BLAIR
(Slurred)
No way, I'm here for the party too
man!

Destiny isn't amused.

DESTINY
Very funny.

BLAIR
My dad's coming too.

DESTINY
Oh Rudy's gonna be here? I love his
brownies, they're so chocolatey.

Destiny turns back to Emily.

DESTINY (CONT'D)
Did you learn how to break the
spell?

EMILY
Uh...

Destiny sighs again.

DESTINY
Your mother and I really need to
spend more time teaching you these
things if you're going to pursue
magic.

Suddenly a huge gust of wind starts blowing at the crowd.

Meredith screams as she hurdles toward the ground with the
box under her arm.

She makes a sharp stop in front of Emily and Destiny, hovering in the air on her broom holding the package.

MEREDITH

Hiya.

She lifts her wind goggles.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

Wow, big turn out. Good job Emily.

Meredith sees Destiny shaking her head.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

Did you invite all these people?

Emily frowns, and shrugs.

EMILY

MEREDITH

(shouting)

--You enchanted the whole town?!

Destiny nods.

MEREDITH (CONT'D)

I'm so proud of you!

Destiny grows very confused.

DESTINY

But also, this is horribly unethical.

MEREDITH

She's learning how to use her powers!

DESTINY

She manipulated the entire town!

BLAIR

Isn't it so cool?

DESTINY

Not it's not!

MEREDITH

It is!

DESTINY (CONT'D)

We need to set a good example for our daughter.

MEREDITH

I know, but this can be easily fixed.

Meredith moves Emily aside. The two of them puts her hands together and close their eyes. When they open them, their eyes glow a bright white.

They both draw a glowing circle in air with other symbols in each one. Meredith and Destiny stretch out their arms, and a huge gust of wind emits from the circles.

Waves of color flow through the air, the eyes of all the people under the spell glow, sparkles dance in the air.

They then shove the circles of light at the crowd. All the townspeople's eyes stop glowing. Everyone is mildly confused and goes home.

DESTINY

Go home.

RANDOM CITIZEN 1

What am I doing here?

RANDOM CITIZEN 2

I though the Brew is closed on Sundays.

Slowly, the crowd disburses with the exception of [the 4 other people that legitimately were able to come.]

EMILY

I'm sorry everyone.

There's some indistinguishable angry muttering among some of the townspeople.

LIBRARIAN

Oh no, I'm going to be late for date night!

MEREDITH

Tell Henry I said hi, Sherman!

LIBRARIAN

Will do Destiny!

Sherman the Librarian leaps away on his hind legs.

The remaining people who actually wanted to come to party head inside.

DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. THE BREW, BACKYARD - NIGHT, LATER

Everybody is in a circle, Destiny is strumming her acoustic guitar while sitting on a tree stump and Meredith leads the group in a song. There's a bonfire in the middle of the group.

Emily and Gretchen are eating their cake, Blair's plate is empty, Ozzy hasn't touched his as he's too busy clinging to the fire extinguisher in his arms.

Meredith switches from singing to humming this next part.

DESTINY

Is the bonfire okay, Ozzy?

OZZY

Totally, I'm comfortable.

EMILY

We can put it out if you want.

He takes a deep breathe in and exhales.

OZZY

I think I'll be okay.

EMILY

Thank you for coming.

OZZY

No problem, this is nice.

Meredith stops humming.

MEREDITH

I think it's time for presents.

GRETCHEN

We were supposed to bring presents?

MEREDITH

Oh. No, I just wanna pull out what Destiny and I got her.

Meredith gets up and goes inside.

EMILY

You got me a present?

DESTINY

Of course, it's your birthday party. This is what we do.

EMILY

You two are the best mothers I've
ever had.

Destiny eyes start to water at that statement. Meredith comes
back outside and bring out the Box from earlier.

MEREDITH

Here ya go honey.

She places the box in front of Emily.

EMILY

It's so big!

MEREDITH

Open it.

Meredith smiles as Emily opens it. Once open, the Cat's head
pops out of the box.

CAT

Meow.

Emily eyes grow wide with overwhelming delight.

EMILY

It's a cat!

OZZY

Aww.

BLAIR

Cute.

GRETCHEN

It's so fluffy!

DESTINY

Aww.

MEREDITH

What do you wanna name the little
fella?

Emily sits in awe for a moment.

EMILY

Um...

She looks around, everyone looks at her with anticipation.

EMILY (CONT'D)

I like Liam.

CAT

Meow.

Gretchen points out to the sky.

*

GRETCHEN
Everyone look.

*

BLAIR
It's a shooting star!

OZZY
It's a shooting star!

DESTINY
Make a wish!

Emily embraces her cat and then looks to her mothers.

EMILY
It's already come to true.

FADE TO BLACK.
